EXECUTIVE PROTOCOL OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION BETWEEN SAPIENZA UNIVERSITY OF ROME (ITALY) AND THE FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF ALAGOAS (BRAZIL)

The *Department of Planning, Design, and Technology of Architecture (Faculty of Architecture)* of Sapienza University of Rome, and the *Faculty of Architecture and Urbanism* of the Federal University of Alagoas, in order to put into practice the General Agreement signed on 04/09/2014, as well as considering the development of cultural and scientific cooperation to be of mutual advantage to both Universities and desiring to reinforce such cooperation, agree on the following points:

Art. 1: Scientific and educational cooperation shall be undertaken in the field(s) of:

- a) Urban History;
- b) Landscape Studies;
- c) Informal Cities and Peripheries;
- d) Digital Humanities;
- e) Tangible and Intangible Heritage;
- f) Regional and Urban Design
- g) Culture and Territory
- h) History and Critical Thinking
- i) Housing and Urbanism

Such cooperation shall be carried out on the basis of equal and mutual advantage, reserving the opportunity to define, through mutual consent, further fields of activity.

Furthermore, this consent will take into consideration the budget available at that moment in time and the experience acquired by the interested scholars from both Universities.

Art. 2: In order to achieve the objectives set out in the first article, scientific and educational cooperation may be implemented in the following ways:

- a) exchange of visits by scholars;
- b) participation in research programmes;
- c) organization of scientific meetings, seminars and courses on subject(s) laid down in the agreement;
- d) exchange of scientific information and scientific papers.

Art. 3: To implement the afore-mentioned points, it is possible to promote a reciprocal exchange of scientific staff between both Universities, in accordance with the available budget. The contracting parties undertake to cover the cost of round trips undertaken by their own scholars (visiting professors). Stay costs shall be covered by the host University, in accordance with applicable norms and regulations in force in both the University and in the host country. The exchange of scholars, in the conditions stated above, shall be based on a condition of each University.
